OSU History



John Smith is a name synonymous with wrestling success.

The Oklahoma State head coach won six consecutive world championships as a competitor from 1987-92, including gold medals at the 1988 Olympic Games in Seoul and at the 1992 Olympic Games in Barcelona, and he owns five national championships as head coach of the Cowboys.



In 1993, a new era began as John Smith became the seventh head coach in Oklahoma State school history. In just two years, coach Smith once again led the Cowboys to the title, claiming OSU's 30th NCAA championship. Adding national championships in 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006, Smith has led his alma mater to four of the last five NCAA crowns, and the

Cowboys now have 34 NCAA team championships. That is more national titles than any other school has in any sport. During the remarkable history of OSU wrestling, unbeaten streaks of 70 (1921-32 under Gallagher), 73 (1996-2000 under Smith), 76 (1937-51 under Gallagher and Griffith) and 84 (1959-66 under Roderick) duals were reeled off by the Cowboys.

Smith was recognized as the National Wrestling Coaches Association coach of the year in 1994 and 2003 and is an 11-time selection as his conference's coach of the year (1994 and 1996 in the Big Eight and 1997, 1998, 2001, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2010 and 2011 in the Big 12).

A native of Del City, Okla., Smith owns a 311-46-6 career dual match record as a head coach (.865 winning pct.).

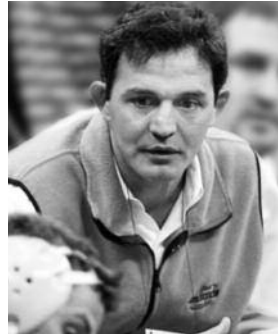

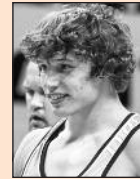

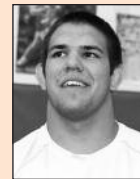
